EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Further to decision record 2021.038 which provides detail around Project Zeal in both the City and the County. Further discussions have taken place in the City about how the £15,000 will be allocated and rather than the £15,000 going to Framework in the City as detailed in decision record 2021.038 the plan is as follows:

- £12,000 to go to Livingstone House – via a funding agreement with the PCC – to provide drug and alcohol misuse treatment and rehabilitation support; and
- £3,000 to Framework or Nottinghamshire Police to manage in relation to care package arrangements to support greater social functioning of offenders.

INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (eg report or business case)

A funding agreement will be put in place with Livingstone House to provide a range of drug and alcohol misuse treatment and rehabilitation support based on the 12 step programme for offenders referred into Livingstone House by Framework's Clean Slate Service. The service will work in partnership with Clean Slate to ensure smooth transition into and out of Livingstone House. This will be for up to £12,000 between 1st November 2021 and 30th June 2022.


The final £3,000 will be kept to support greater social functioning of offenders. Criteria for the social functioning fund will be drawn up by the Clean Slate service and will then be managed by either Framework or Nottinghamshire Police.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

This funding will be drawn down from reserves – see decision record 2021.038 for further detail.


Up to £12,000 will be provided to Livingstone House to provide a range of drug and alcohol misuse treatment and rehabilitation support; and up to £3,000 will be provided to support greater social functioning of offenders.
