EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:
This decision notice seeks approval of £5790 +VAT of spend from the Late Night Levy fund for the provision of prevention tools in the Night Time Economy.


INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (eg report or business case)
<p>A coordinated partnership response has been established in response to recent reports of spiking in Nottingham City during October 2021. A number of preventative measures have been proposed to provide reassurance to members and visitors to the Night Time Economy.</p> <p>This decision note seeks approval of £5790 + VAT of spend from the Late Night Levy fund for the following items, which have been prioritised by partners, including the OPCC, VRU, Nottinghamshire Police, the Business Improvement District and Pubwatch.</p> <p>Knife wands – x50 for licensed premises deemed to be 'high risk', including those venues already targeted, to be distributed to licensed premises. Venues with the licencing condition to use Metal Detecting wands have an obligation to do so and checks will be conducted by the Police Licencing Team to ensure compliance, those venues without a specific condition are encouraged to make use of this valuable resource. Their use increases the chance of detecting sharp implements such as needles and knives and reduces the risk of injury for the person conducting the search, in doing so it keeps the venues safe for the public by removing these potentially dangerous items</p> <p>'Stop Tops' – x12,500 'Stop Tops' to be distributed to licensed premises as a prevention tool to prevent spiking of drinks. These are already being used in most premises, this will boost the existing supply.</p> <p>Urine testing kits – x100 to enable initial testing of urine samples, this will enable officers to prioritise positive samples to be sent for forensic analysis. This tool has been proposed by the City NP Team and Force NTE Lead, Insp Anwaar Ahmed in consultation with Devon and Cornwall Police.</p>


