- £10,000 to Chayah Development Project for their Police and Community Dialogue initiative which aims to break down stigmas and barriers between the police and community and foster better relationships.


### INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (eg report or business case)

Chayah Development Project approached the PCC and the Police for £10,000 for activity and spend by the end of this financial year (31<sup>st</sup> March 2022). The funding will enable them to develop their Police and Community Dialogue initiative which aims to break down stigmas and barriers between the police and community and foster better relationships. The funding will contribute to:


- The hosting of community events which will be led by police representatives to address matters arising in the community – to foster better relationships and gain public confidence;
- The running of drop in sessions in hot spots – St Anns, Radford, Meadows, Stapleford, Top Valley, Bulwell, Arnold, New Basford, Clifton, Strelley and Aspley – these drop in sessions will also enable them to create 3 focus groups.
- Ongoing referrals from the police for young people/ families to receive support, training, personal coaching; and
- An increase in the number of youth coaches and mentors available to Chayah.


This activity will be undertaken and the funding spent by the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022.
