<b>EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:</b>
<p>This proposal seeks approval for the VRU to provide a three-month extension of funding counselling services provided by Al Hurrayah and Base 51 to avoid attrition of specialist staff. The extension will take place from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 30<sup>st</sup> June 2022.</p>


<b>INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (eg report or business case)</b>
<p>Al Hurrayah and Base 51 currently have grants to deliver therapeutic counselling through their respective Growth and Evolution projects up until 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022 via the Community Safety and Violence Reduction Fund 2021-22. This notice of decision seeks approval for a further £12,500 of funding between the aforementioned providers to continue this specialist work until such time that a full tender exercise is completed.</p> <p>The funding amount is based on current grant agreements with both organisations who were awarded £25,000 for the period of the financial year 2021/22. £6250 will be awarded to each organisation for delivery during Q1 of 2022/23</p> <p>A loss in service between funding arrangements could result in the attrition of specialist staff and a detrimental effect upon the vulnerable and high risk children and young people receiving therapeutic counselling support. There is no provision for the funding of the therapeutic interventions in the new Make Notts Safe fund approach – the VRU will be undertaking an open tender exercise, however due to the capacity of staff within the VRU and procurement team, it will not be possible to establish new contracts with providers for therapeutic interventions before end of June.</p>
