Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA)

I write in connection with your request for information, which was received by the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner on 27 March 2013.

RESPONSE

Under S 1 (1) (a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), I can confirm that the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner does hold some of the information you have requested.

Please find below answers to your questions:-

The Police and Crime Commissioner has made one appointment since November 2012, thus being Chris Cutland the Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner. Chris works 3 days per week and her salary is £36,000.

The Commissioner has worked professionally with the Deputy Commissioner over many years. She has a vast knowledge and track record in domestic abuse services.

By virtue of s.18 of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, the Police and Crime Commissioner may appoint a person to be Deputy. The Police and Crime Panel endorsed the appointment of the Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner on 3 December 2012.

The estimated budget for the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner is £1.2m for 2012-13. This does not include any payment in relation to the Police & Crime Panel as we do not administer this. Nottinghamshire County Council is the appropriate Authority in this regard.

For comparative purposes the last full year budget for the Police Authority was 2011-12 where the total budget was also £1.2m (excluding the change management team that was employed). There has been a standstill budget of £1.2m for 4 years and in 2012-13 a saving of £0.1m was made against this budget.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your interest in the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner.
