INFORMATION REQUESTED and RESPONSE

Under S 1 (1) (a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), I can confirm that the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner does hold the information you have requested.

1. Has the money already been spent on Street Pastors (or has this just been approved at this stage)?

The money has not yet been spent; it has been approved in principle.

2. How much has been spent or to be spent on Street Pastors?

Funding starts from April 2016 so none has been spent so far. £12,000 per annum for 3 years will be spent towards the running and support costs to maintain the Street Pastors.
