Thank you for your request for information, which was received by the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner on 10 May 2018.

INFORMATION REQUESTED

I would appreciate your help in identifying the following figures for your police force for each year from 2011 to 2017:

- 1. How many dogs were seized by your Police Force under Section 1 of the Dangerous Dogs Act (DDA) 1991?
- 1.2 Of the dogs seized as prohibited types:
- i. can you provide a break down into the four different prohibited types?
- ii. How many were prosecuted under Section 1 of the DDA?
- iii. how many were also charged with an offence under Section 3 of the same Act?
- iv. how many were exempted using the Section 4b process?
- v. what is the average length of time taken to exempt a dog using the Section 4b process?
- vi. how many dogs were destroyed by a) court order and b) with the owner's consent?
- 2. Has your Force implemented the Interim Exemption Scheme (IES)?
- 2.1 If your force has implemented IES:
- i. how many times has it been used?
- ii. what is the average time taken for a dog to be seized and returned home using the IES?
- 3. What is the average time taken to prosecute for a Section 1 offence?
