Thank you for your request for information, which was received by the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner on 4 March 2019.

INFORMATION REQUESTED

I realise train fares and accommodation expenses are paid directly by Notts. OPCC

I notice train fares expenses amounted to £5,901 for 2017 / 2018

This averages at £492 per month.

As Mr. Tipping is entitled to a senior rail card which greatly reduces train fares I am surprised at the high cost.

RESPONSE

Under S 1 (1) (a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), I can confirm that the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner does hold the information you have requested.

Please find below answers to your questions:

The Commissioner does have a Senior rail card. Most of the journeys are London return at peak times and wherever we can we book in advance to obtain the cheaper rail fare.
