## INFORMATION REQUESTED

How many times did the PCC/Mayor write directly to the former Prime Minister Rt Hon Theresa May MP during her time in office both as prime minister and Home Secretary for the following reasons:

- A: Raising concerns that budget cuts were having a detrimental effect on policing
- B: Requested more money? How much was requested how much was given (if any)
- C: Raised concerns that budget cuts were putting officers at risk

## **RESPONSE**

Under S 1 (1) (a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), I can confirm that the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner does hold the information you have requested.

Please find below answers to your questions:-

I can confirm the Nottinghamshire Police & Crime Commissioner did write directly to the former Prime Minister Rt Hon Theresa May during her time in office as the Home Secretary. The PCC wrote on three occasions raising concerns over budget cuts and the impact on Policing. No specific amount of money was requested.
