I am making enquiries about spillages of Category 3 animal by-products from lorries travelling on the local road network to the J G Pears factory at Low Marnham.

These spillages are becoming more frequent and dangerous to local residents and other road users in the area.

I would be very grateful if you could tell me if these spillages are reported to, and recorded by the Police, and if this information is available to the public. Also if there have ever been any prosecutions of this company or their contractors for these spillages.
