Thank you for your request for information, which was received by the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner on 26 June 2013.

INFORMATION REQUESTED

I would like to add to the FOI I submitted based on 'Top 30 sexual offedners' (or resubmit it if your constabulary was unable to respond to it).

Instead I would like the total number of arrests made in the constabulary catchment area since 2009 for the following offences:

Rape

Sexual assault

Administering a substance (drinks spiking)

Trepass with intent to commit a sexual offence

Sexual intercourse with a girl under the age of 16

Abuse of trust through a sexual activity

Sexual activity by a care worker

Engaging in a sexual activity in the presence of a child

Sexual grooming

Sexual activity with a family member

Abudction

Indecent conduct towards a child

Taking an indecent photograph of a child

Causing or inciting child prostitution

Procuring a woman by threats or false pretences

Trafficking a person into the UK for sexual exploitation

Exposure

Voyeurism

If it is possible to know who the most prolific offender for each of these offences (based on the number of arrests/charges/convictions then I would like to add that too my request.

Finally, I would like to add one more request:

I would like the postcode (street address) that has experienced the most arrests based on prostitution since 2009.
