INFORMATION REQUESTED

I would like to ask the following questions regarding your budget for 2013/2014:

- 1) How much money is specifically allocated to the prevention of gangs and youth violence?
- 2) Are any voluntary sector organisations being utilised to provide these services?
- 3) If so, please provide a list of organisations and details of the funding they have been awarded (including the value, type (contract/grant etc) and duration of funding)

RESPONSE

Under S 1 (1) (a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), I can confirm that the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner does hold the information you have requested.

- 1. The Nottinghamshire Crime Drug Partnership has been allocated £422,000 for 2013/14 for prevention of gang and youth violence.
- 2. It is anticipated that voluntary organisations will be used to provide these services.
- 3. To date no contracts have been awarded.
