Thank you for your request for information, which was received by the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner on 2 July 2013.

INFORMATION REQUESTED

I would like to request information relating to money paid out under the Riot Damages Act 1886 for claims made between August 6th 2011 and September 22nd 2011.

- a) **How many claims were made** to your authority under the Riot Damages Act 1886 between August 6th 2011 and September 22nd 2011?
- b) What was the total amount paid out by your authority under the Riot Damages Act 1886 for claims made between August 6th 2011 and September 22nd 2011?
- c) How many claims made between August 6th and September 22nd 2011 were rejected by your authority?
- d) How many claims made between August 6th and September 22nd 2011 are still outstanding?

RESPONSE

Under S 1 (1) (a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), I can confirm that the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner does hold the information you have requested.

- a) 28 Claims were made to Nottinghamshire Police Authority under the Riot Damages Act 1886 between August 6th 2011 and September 22nd 2011
- b) As the claims made were for vehicle damage and business interruption no amount was paid as these types of claim are not covered by the Riot Damages Act.
- c) 28 claims were rejected for the reasons mentioned above.
- d) There are no claims outstanding.
