Thank you for your request for information, which was received by the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner on 5<sup>th</sup> August 2013.

## **INFORMATION REQUESTED**

Since being voted into position could you please detail:

- What domestic and/or sexual violence services have you have commissioned/piloted/trialled/given either solely as the PCC or with any other partners/stakeholders, etc
- Which organisations delivered any work commissioned
- How those organisations were selected to deliver work if no tender/expression of interest/open tender or other selection type process was used, please explain why
- The length and value of any such work and what evaluation there will be
- How will future domestic and/or sexual violence work that is paid for by the PCC, or work that is jointly commissioned with the PCC be widely and fairly advertised within Nottinghamshire?

## RESPONSE

Under S 1 (1) (a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), I can confirm that the Nottinghamshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner does hold the information you have requested.

Please find below answers to your questions:-

A variety of funding has been made available by the Police and Crime Commissioner for work in this area, for example:

- Commissioned work via the Crime and Disorder Partnership (CDP) and Safer Nottinghamshire Board (SNB) (contact them directly for details)
- Paid small grants to several third sector organisations working in this area. (Details would take significant time to analyse and produce)

The main element in response to your question is:



• In process of commissioning of specific piece of work in relations to Medium Risk Plus across City and County to reduce domestic abuse, particularly repeat victims. The specification and details of process will be available on the website shortly.
