INTRODUCTION

What is Safer Streets?

Safer Streets is a Home Office funded initiative to improve safety in public spaces and also to make people feel safer when they are out and about. It is particularly targeted at helping to reduce neighbourhood crime and antisocial behaviour and preventing violence against women and girls.

Police and Crime Commissioners work in partnership with local councils to bid for funding, which can be used on projects such as new CCTV cameras, street lighting, youth provision and home security devices. Nottinghamshire Police and Nottingham City Council will deliver the project in Clifton and Bulwell with the support of the Safer Streets partnership.

What is the money being spent on?

Due to a change in regulations only allowing for a maximum of three bids, which would have excluded the city. The Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Nottinghamshire has committed £333,000 of funding for projects in Nottingham City to ensure the people of Nottingham don't miss out.

Nottinghamshire Police and Nottingham City Council will use the funding to carry out:

- Three new HD-CCTV cameras in Bulwell and four in Clifton.
- Three new ANPR cameras in Bulwell and Clifton.
- Environmental improvements such as: installation of fencing, graffiti removal, hedge trimming and more in Bulwell and Clifton.
- Free home security devices for residents in Clifton and Bulwell.
- Attitudinal outreach activities for young people in Clifton and Bulwell.
