TITLE: AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

The purpose of this report is to recommend approval for the signing of a call-off contract against the Crown Commercial Services Framework Agreement, for the Supply of Electricity and Ancillary Services, to Nottinghamshire Police force locations, for the period of 1 April 2016 to 31 March 2017 only. The current spend in this area is circa £526,000 and a budget has been confirmed as continuing to exist in this area of spend for the force.

2. SUPPORTING INFORMATION

Nottinghamshire Police have historically been provided electricity in recent years through an arrangement with EDF Energy via the Crown Commercial Services. The Crown Commercial Services are a contracting authority body which put in place a whole array of framework agreements for use by UK police forces including in the area of energy. The CCS have traditionally been a major contracting authority for the putting in place energy framework agreements in particular for use across the UK public sector due to the significant advantages that come from the collaborative purchasing power they are to leverage within the market from combining requirements of organisations across whole areas of the public sector.

The force continues to have a requirement for the provision of electricity top its various sites clearly and whilst other potential avenues of supply have / are being looked into for the future supply of electricity to the force which may yield still further cost advantages to the force, that work is not yet complete and any outcomes are therefore not conclusive at this stage.

With that in mind it is therefore now imperative that the existing call-off agreement with EDF Energy for the supply of electricity is signed in the meantime to ensure that contractual relations are properly formalised between the parties so as to ensure the ongoing continuity of supply to 31 March 2017 on a foundation of firm contractual relations.

This call-off agreement currently implies no definite binding commitment beyond 31 March 2017.
