TITLE: AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR SIGNALS FROM NOISE EXTENSION (TRI FORCE)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

To recommend approval for the award of a contract for 'Signals from Noise' Extension on behalf of the Tri-Force management for the period up to 31 March 2018 to Lightfoot for the contract value of £78,660.

2. SUPPORTING INFORMATION

This is a provision for a trial instance of Signals for Noise for Leicestershire (and Nottinghamshire). The Tri-Force Agile Working strategy seeks to have a fully joined up Tri-force approach with common standards, application and devices. Both Nottinghamshire and Leicestershire Forces have already identified a need for Predictive and Analytical capabilities and because Northamptonshire Police use the 'Signals from Noise' successfully, it is consider appropriate to test it in Leicestershire and Nottinghamshire.

INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (e.g. report or business case)

The East Midlands Strategic Commercial Unit (EMSCU) is procuring this resource on behalf of Leicestershire and Nottinghamshire Police through the issue of a single tender approved by Tri-Force Assistant Chief Officer - IT, Phil Eaton. The intention is to acquire temporary licenses; support from Lightfoot to overcome potential issues regarding the data re-aggregation, reporting matrix and reporting measures and the best practise for the use additional predictive capabilities and training to provide a Test Instance of 'Signals from Noise' on a temporary basis in 2017, prior to the determination of a permanent solution. In response to the invitation, Lightfoot submitted a priced solution totalling £113,160 but following discussions the scope of the provision was scaled back reducing the number of licenses required.

Further information on the procurement process and its outcomes can be made available from EMSCU if required.
