EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Further to Decision Record 2021.022 which outlined the award of 18 grants to third sector organisations via the 2021.22 Community Safety and Violence Reduction Unit Fund, this is to request approval to provide additional funding to one of the grant recipients as follows:

- The provision of an additional up to £4,000 to Switch Up CIC for ongoing mentoring work.


This is a financial commitment of up to £4,000 which will come from the Commissioner's 2021/22 Community Safety Grant and will be spent before 31st March 2022.

INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (eg report or business case)


In April 2021 Switch Up CIC was awarded a grant via the 2021.22 Community Safety and Violence Reduction Unit Fund. This grant was provided to enable Switch Up to provide targeted mentoring to at risk young people in both Nottingham City and Mansfield.


Due in the main to Covid 19, demand for the project from vulnerable young people has been higher than anticipated meaning that the initial grant was fully spent by the end of December 2021. In order to ensure that those young people currently being mentored as a result of the PCC funding additional funding has been sought. This additional funding will allow the mentees to continue to be mentored and a suitable exit plan put in place for them. The additional funding will provide additional mentoring hours from January 2022 to the end of March 2022.
