<b>EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:</b>
<p>The PCC is requested to confirm her approval to provide a further grant to Leaders Unlocked to develop a Youth Independent Advisory Group for Nottinghamshire and undertake peer-led engagement with young people on the subject of trust and confidence in the police and feelings of safety in public among young women and girls.</p> <p>The funding for this would run from October 2022 to August 2023 at a cost of £33,950 split across the two financial years. The funding would come from the Community Safety Grant.</p>

<b>INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF DECISION: (eg report or business case)</b>
<p>The PCC has been grant funding Leaders Unlocked to provide a Youth Commission service since May 2015. The OPCC would now like to look at a new model of working with young people and as such is looking to fund Leaders Unlocked to deliver a new time limited proof of concept initiative. This includes the establishment of a Youth Independent Advisory Group and peer-led engagement that will support key objectives of the Nottinghamshire Make Notts Safe Plan relating to trust and confidence in the police and feelings of safety among young women and girls.</p> <p>The PCC recognises the additional value offered via the Leaders Unlocked national infrastructure which has led to sharing of ideas and good practice among other national Youth Commissions and the involvement of Nottinghamshire members in relevant national programmes of activity.</p> <p>This new initiative will run from October 2022 to August 2023 at a cost of £33,950 split across the two financial years. The new initiative will be continually reviewed to help inform future commissioning arrangements in this area.</p>
