EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The PCC is requested to approve up to £32,018 to be spent on the Red Flags of Fraud campaign.

This to confirm in writing previous verbal agreement to proceed with the campaign, which aimed to respond to increase reporting of fraud. The campaign was delivered during February 2024.

Nottinghamshire Fraud Partnership was formed in 2023 to work together to protect individuals and businesses in Nottinghamshire from fraudulent activity. Members of the partnership have signed up to the Fraud Partnership charter.

The campaign includes the ability to claim a free fraud advice booklet detailing different types of fraud and how to report it.
